Name

When referring to the College and 4-H organization...

- Use UConn not UCONN
- Use 4-H not 4H



When should I use logos/ names?

On everything! All communications from your club and county should include UConn Extension and 4-H. The 4-H name and emblem also needs to be included on apparel, signage, displays, banners and items such as robots that include sponsors or organizational branding.

What is the official 4-H Clover?

- The stem of the clover goes to the right
- The statment "18 USC 707" must legibly appear
- The color is either official 4-H Green or black/white



Logos

- Don't distort or stretch logo (size proportionately)
- Don't make the logos too small OR too large.
- Do not put anything behind or in front of logos
- ONLY USE THE OFFICIAL 4-H CLOVER
- USE ONLY THE OFFICIAL UCONN LOGO

UConn Branding Standards allow for flexibility, keep to similar styles if you don't have access to these fonts. Below are popular recommendations. Serif fonts work best in print. Sans serif fonts work best for online.

 New Roman for main body text in printed
 materials.
- Arial, Avenir, Proxima Nova or Open Sans for main body text for online materials.
